Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing with a few updates from our temporary base here at NUSA. First of all I would like to say a big thank you to you all for your support and understanding since we had to leave Firbeck on Friday. We understand that this has all been a bit unsettling for some but we have been so lucky to all be relocated to NUSA and to have access to such fantastic facilities. The children have settled in really well, are enjoying their new space and absolutely loving the dinners!

We will update you on when we will be back at Firbeck but we will certainly be here for tomorrow and some or all of next week. Please make sure we have your most recent contact details in the office and keep checking our website for updates.

After school clubs such as the new family learning club have had to be cancelled but Area Band is still going ahead today (Thursday), you should have already received a letter about this.

The Bilborough Arts festival is still going ahead this weekend. Unfortunately as we have not been able to finish our entries, Firbeck won't be displaying any work this weekend. We will try and get it finished and displayed for you to see when we are back at Firbeck.

Year 6s were due to be doing their Bikeability training this week, I have spoken to a representative from Ridewise and we are trying to rearrange the sessions before the end of the term. I will keep you up to date when we have confirmed the dates.

Next week, the Reception class are going on their trip to the Sea Life Centre, if we are still based at NUSA we will simply rearrange collection from here, so the trip will go ahead as normal. Please see Mrs Johnstone if you have any other questions.
