This will help develop our reading and writing skills. We will work on letter formation and pencil control.</p> <p>We will write about our family and ourselves. We will also complete a non-fiction animal fact file.</p>	<p><u>Mathematics</u></p> <p>We will be working on our basic number skills. We will be developing a firm understanding of numbers through a range of practical activities. We will also be looking at 2D shapes and using them to create patterns.</p> <p>We will be placing numbers in order and will say which number is one more or one less than a given number. We will also begin to do some addition and subtraction.</p>
