### Topic

This half term our topic is Under the Ocean. We will be looking at different things that live under the ocean and discuss how we can look after them.

#### Over the course of this half term we will be looking closely at the following texts:

We will also be working really hard to develop our handwriting and presentation skills.

We will be doing a daily phonics session following the Ruth Miskin scheme. This will help develop our reading and writing skills. We will work on letter formation and pencil control.

We will be working on using different adjectives in our writing. We will be learning how to write facts about under water creatures.

#### **Mathematics**

We will be continuing to work on numbers to 20. We will look at 1 more and 1 less. We will be using the Maths Mastery approach. We will be looking at sharing, doubling and halving.

We will also be focussing on Shape, Space and Measure by learning about shapes and measures of different things.

Our maths work will be done through a selection of practical activities using different resources.

#### **STEM**

We will be looking at Knowledge and Understanding of the World by looking at our favourite books and the books of our families. We will also look at natural things outside and how we can use them for Outdoor learning.

We will be learning about life under the ocean with some focus on environmental issues.

#### Well-being:

Throughout our curriculum we will be looking at the differences between each other and celebrating friendships and relationships.
