English

After successfully writing biographies about Mary Seacole, we are moving onto writing narratives all about space. We will be learning how we can add detail to our writing by using expanded noun phrases and ad verbs.

Maths

Last term, we looked at multiplication and division. This term, the maths curriculum will be looking at measurement. This will include content such as telling the time, measuring lengths of objects and counting money. These are all key skills we use in everyday life and therefore maybe worth giving extra practice at home.

Science

This term, we will be studying plants. The children will learn about seeds, how they grow and how to care for them. We will be completing many practical lessons such as planting our own seeds and watching them grow.

History

Linking to our English, we will be learning about the moon landing such as its conspiracies, why and how do astronauts go to the moon. Throughout this topic they will be learning keys such as identifying clues and inferring what they might mean.
