

COVID-19 Catch-up Premium

Context:

Uptake of remote learning: variable – the top 10% have undertaken every task set, the bottom 20% minimal engagement

Uptake of paper- learning: variable – of the bottom 20% above, half have engaged with paper-based tasks given as an alternative

Uptake of summer term return to school: Year 2 = approximately 40%

Uptake of summer term return to school: Year 6 = approximately 50%

Baseline of Y2 and KS2 children undertaken in September 2020

Expected government covid-catch up fund = £13,920
