We have a very exciting summer term and end of the academic year ahead. There are many things that are happening behind the scenes that you might not be aware of, the following information will help you understand how truly special Firbeck Academy is!

We are currently working towards gaining an **Eco Schools Award**, supported by Mrs Mitchell. To continue to achieve this, we need to ensure we are reusing, recycling and reducing our waste at home and at school.

To support this, please:

Some of the **trips** and **experiences** that our children have had this year, have been remarkable. From inspiration days at the University of Nottingham; trips further afield to Crich Tramway Museum and Creswell Crags; This Girl Can sports events and visits from local everyday heroes.

The Co-op store at Bramcote Lane have very kindly donated a fruit tree for the King's Coronation. This will be planted in our allotment.

Book boxes are often topped up with new and exciting titles. Please help yourself - we aim to build your personal libraries at home, so help yourself! Our boxes can be found on the bottom playground or children can help themselves to the box in the KS1 corridor.

**Reading Leaders** are our reading role models. They are passionate about reading and support our staff to ensure the library is well organised.

**Dance** is used to express ourselves and to support emotional and educational needs. After-school dance club has been funded by the **Samworth Foundation**. Children have learned a variety of routines which they have performed both in front of the whole school and during public events.

We have a range of **After-school clubs** for children in Y1 to 6 to immerse themselves in. From arts and crafts, to football. Most recently, our **Football Team** had a visit from Brocklewood. Mr Denty and Mrs Bowles will continue their coaching.

Every Tuesday, we have a visit from Music Hub to develop and lead music in Y4 & Y5. Children are given opportunities to play instruments, learn various melodies and perform in public. One of their most recent performances was part of the Great Youth Orchestra, where schools from around the city came together to become a united orchestra.

Student Council have been an important voice who represent pupil voice. They have been involved in our recruitment process, interviewing candidates, meeting our CEO, completing school tours, presenting assemblies to the school about important issues and much more. One of the areas they recognised we needed to improve on was on how we recycled in the classroom. They identified the issue, discussed the best possible ways to improve this, presented to the school and launched the class recycling bins.







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We have a range of **volunteers** in school, including reading volunteers. It is greatly appreciated to help enhance the experiences our children have during their learning journey at Firbeck Academy.
