English

After creating some fantastic fiction narratives around the theme of Space, this term we are looking at instruction writing about how we made our Easter cakes at the end of last term. We are going to be looking at how we lay out instructions so that they are easy to follow as well how concise and informative each instruction is.

Maths

In preparation for the SATS in May we will be revisiting and reviewing previous learning such as number bonds, partitioning and multiplication and division. Please keep accessing the resources at home such as the booklets from parents evening, numbots and times tables rockstars as these will really boost your child's confidence.

Science

This term, we will continue with the studying of plants. The children will be conducting lots of different investigations such as does a seed have a top and bottom and does the size of the seed affect the size of the plant?

Geography

In Geography we will be exploring the topic of food by identifying the difference between fresh, frozen and take away food. We will also be looking at the stages of production from the raw product to the finished food which we can find on our supermarket shelves.
